Brooke Grove ES OASIS Tutors

Carderock Springs ES Carderock Buddies: 100 of our 3rd-5th grade general education students self-select to be mentors for our students in the self-contained autism program.

Peer Tutoring: We use social emotional student survey data to identify at risk 3rd-5th grade students and pair them up with younger students as mentors. Kindergarteners are paired with 3rd graders. 1st graders are paired with 4th graders. 2nd graders are paired with 5th graders. There are approximately 35 peer tutor pairings.

Staff Buddies: We use social emotional student survey data to identify at risk students in K-5th grade and pair each student with a staff mentor. There are approximately 15 Staff Buddy pairings.
