## Academic Recovery/Tutoring

- Each school is expected to offer tutoring to their students, either through their own staff members or through providing information to families to sign up for Tutor Me or FEV.
- No limit to the number of tutors, students, or hours.
- Tutors will use MCPS curriculum or one of the approved MCPS interventions.
- Strive for 3-5 times per week to maximize impact.
- Our goal is to move to in-person tutoring from internal staff and external vendors (working with transportation)

# Academic Recovery/Tutoring

## Parent Advocacy:

- Using academic data, schools will reach out to parents for tutoring.
- Parents may request tutoring services by contacting their teacher. However, In-person tutoring services will be given to those students who need it first.
- Any student can receive tutoring services through FEV or TutorMe (online).
